Winter/Spring 09 Praises

- Our furlough in the States was better than we could have imagined. We were ministered to by our supporters and family in countless ways. God's love for Ukraine and His plan for our ministries were clearly communicated.
- Youth ministry continued on at New Life without us ;) More than that, Elements (Bible study curriculum) small group was formed. A new set of 15-yr. old leaders are being invested in, and a new ministry is springing from this.
- God provided financially for our entire 2008 calendar year. Although we've lost supporters over the past 2 yrs., He continues to be there.

Spring 09 Prayer Requests

- Clarity for next summer. We really want to find a few new Ukrainian youth groups in the Lviv area who are interested in evangelism camps with Josiah Venture.
- We want to hire a Ukrainian to help us with some JV summer logistics and strategy.
- Kristy and Brittney are starting a 10-wk. English-speaking Bible study for non-Christian girls in Lviv. Pray that students come! Pray for big things!
- Ben really wants to start volunteering in English in a local high-school. Pray that the door is opened to him, and for deeper friendships with teenage guys, regardless of the language barrier.
- Kristy's brother, Michael, age 23, has been with the US National Guard in Afghanistan since August. He is in a very dangerous place as he fights w/ the Afghani police against the Taliban. Pray for his safety, and also for his wife, Margie, and their marriage. He is trusting the Lord with his life.

Late Fall 08 Praises

- October has been full of joy in ministry; we love being back in Lviv and serving in our local church. That is really where our passion to work w/ youth is the deepest.
- The JV Fall conference was amazing, practical teaching about loving the church as the bride of Christ. Our Ukrainian guests, esp. Syava, were blessed by it as well.
- We are so thankful to experience first hand the growth in our youth leaders, even since this summer. They launched a Sunday night Bible study for people who want to follow God deeper. Soon they are starting small groups for students from camp.
- The end of summer was full of travel. We enjoyed Croatia w/ JV missionary kids, and Africa for vacation w/ Ben's dad & step-mom. It was much needed rest.

Late Fall 08 Prayer Requests

- Kristy's brother, Michael, age 23, is in his 3rd month with the US National Guard in Afghanistan. He is in a very dangerous place as he fights w/ the Afghani police against the Taliban. Pray for his safety, and also for his wife, Margie. He is trusting the Lord.
- Josiah Venture is launching an 11-city US tour to celebrate what God has done in Eastern Europe over the past 15 years and to raise money for some big org needs. We are praying for 4,000 participants in these events.
- We are asking God for continued contact w/ the 75 students who were at our Lviv camp. There were also 4 other camps with 225 other Ukrainians. All of our Ukr. youth group teams are trying to follow up w/ campers and spur them on in their relationship w/ Jesus.

- Nov. 9 – Jan. 22 we will be in the States for our 1st furlough. We pray for great reconnection w/ our churches, supporters, and family. We pray for God to provide for increased financial needs for the coming years as well.

Summer 08 Prayer Requests

- We sense a lot of uncertainty, fear, and even disobedience in the Ukr small group leaders at camp. Pray for them to be empowered by the Holy Spirit.
- Pray for healthy partnership between JV missionaries, the national church teams, and the short term US teams. There are a lot of responsibilities and roles to share.
- We're expecting 92 American short term visitors and 3 college student interns for 2.5 months this summer. Pray that God grow their heart for reaching the lost with the Gospel.
- Pray that God will open the eyes of students, that they will see that life is nothing without a relationship w/ Jesus.
- The severe inflation in Ukraine and the weakening dollar has really put constraints on our camp budget. Pray for enough camp funds to pay for it all.

Summer 08 Praises

- At the end of June and into July, we'll train and prepare almost 100 American short term participants to serve at Ukrainian English camps.
- Our advertising efforts were really blessed. Students have quickly responded to the invitation to come to English camp. We sense God choosing students HE wants there.
- Details continue to come together as we worked hard to secure facilities, arrange transportation, raise funds, and prepare church leaders for camp.
- We really are enjoying our interns and summer team this summer! It just seems less stressful and easier to care for them than last year.

Spring 2008 Prayer Requests

- Our March & April calendar is a bit overwhelming, but exciting, none-the-less. Three American pastors will visit to check out our ministry before bringing their summer teams over in July. Then a team of Czechs will do a mission trip to help our L'viv church. Pray for energy, hearts to serve, good hospitality, and that people will experience Christ through our work.
- We have about 50 Ukrainian youth leaders & helpers joining us for our annual English Camp Conference in L'viv. We are hosting it, and deeply desire to give them the training they need to be successful in their youth groups before, during, and after camp.
- Pray for English Camp advertising, especially in schools. Kristy will advertise to the university that she is working with. May God stir in students' hearts so they are interested in our Christian camps, and meeting Jesus not only w/ their heads, but also w/ their hearts.
- Ben is writing the English camp talks for our 5 camps this summer. Our talks will be spiritually deeper than in previous years. The Ukrainian pastors are asking for a blend of evangelism and discipleship topics. May God give us the words to say.

Praises From Winter '08

- The Lord of the Harvest has sent us workers! We have about 80 short term team members coming to help with our 5 camps this summer! And we have 2 new interns, as well as Josh, Brittney, & Steph returning for the summer.
- Facility searches have been difficult, but right now 3 of our 4 are secured. Only 1 to go.
- The Global Youth Initiative Conference in Israel impacted us on many levels; we were reminded of our calling to "movements of multiplication" as Jesus did – making disciples who can make disciples and change their world. We also formed deeper bonds w/ other members of Josiah Venture in attendance.

Winter 2008 Prayer Requests

- Pray for students to be moved by the Holy Spirit in their personal walks with Christ. We feel like we're facing a lot of excuses, keeping them from a rich life w/ Christ. Especially pray for a desire for evangelism (inviting new people) & time in the Word.
- We have an immediate prayer need for summer young-adult interns. The application process ends mid-February, and we still have no one 100% committed. Ask the Lord of the harvest to send workers.
- The facility search is on, but we keep coming up short. Pray for the right people connections to find facilities, and that there will be availability during our camp dates.
- We've started forming closer relationships w/ our L'viv youth group ministry team. As we build trust, pray that we can help them cast vision & be intentional for the Kingdom of God.

- Our visas were issued in November. We were able to obtain car insurance in January. And as of last week, we got high speed internet in our apartment! Almost 10 months of waiting, and our prayer was finally answered. We praise God for these victories!

- Christmas, though a bit lonely, came & went w/o homesickness. It was nice to enjoy the holidays in our new culture.
 - Language is coming along nicely. It is nice to feel more & more at ease here.

Fall '07 Prayer Requests

- **IMMEDIATE NEED:** There's been a change in Ukrainian visa requirements. We need clarity from our embassy and theirs to insure we have proper documentation.
- We are about 1 mo. into an intense 9 mo. of Ukrainian language study. May God increase our understanding & ability to communicate in this difficult language.
- Planning for Summer 2008 is already underway! We were challenged by JV to double the # of camps & US/Ukr. churches working together in '08. Pray that we choose the right partnerships and have enough teams to serve next summer.
- We've started weekly meetings/Bible studies/fellowship times w/ key students here in Lviv. We need wisdom from the Spirit to set vision, select training & study materials, & love these students. Pray specifically for Syava, Svieta, Kristina, Eugene, Nadya, & Sasha.

Fall '07 Praises

- We have *finally* entered a healthy routine after a long 4 mo. mostly away from Lviv. Language, office work, and lots of one-on-one time w/ students take up most of our time.
 - Our Lviv youth group began again, and the students are more eager than ever to build relationships w/ us and involve us in their lives. Thank you, Lord, for friends!
 - Our 1st Josiah Venture Fall Leadership Conference (Sept. 17-22) successfully brought together national youth workers and missionaries ministering in 11 different Eastern European countries. We studied topics like "Dealing w/ Legalism in the Church", Issues of Authority, & Removing Roadblocks to Your Ministry. Many European leaders in the church have **very** limited access to ministry training in their countries or in their languages, so this is a huge service that JV provides.

Summer '07 Prayer Requests

- Leading an intern team means overseeing spiritual development, camp logistics, English teaching, laundry/food/housing, fun, traveling all over the country, etc. for our team. This is for 80 days straight, while we also juggle our own life, marriage, attitudes, & relationship with God. Passion, patience, and balance are 3 words that come to mind.
- Pray for relationship building. It often takes time to build trust w/ E. European students. Plus, the language barrier often slows things down. Pray against awkwardness and inability to connect with campers. It is so much easier to be passionate about missions when you connect well w/ students.
- Pray for local church leadership. Honestly, our JV team here does not always see eye-to-eye with the national leadership styles and camp plans. Without unity between our 2 teams, it will make it hard to show the love of Christ in a genuine way. Pray that God remove barriers and make both sides flexible to do God's work the way He wants it.
- Ben is speaking at all of the camps for the evening program. Each night he gives a "talk" (basically a mini sermon w/ a passage from the Bible and a lot of great personal examples) and then dismisses us to our small group discussions. May God speak through Ben and may God open the campers' eyes to hear about Him.
- If you like to pray for people by name, pray for Boris, Lena, Pastor Sergiy, Tolik, Katja, Serigogia, Vanya, Yura, Dale, Yulia, Masha, Jana, Vlad, Sasha, Zhenya, and other Ukrainian youth who desire boldness to lead their

youth groups and tell their friends about Jesus. Pray that they are willing to go outside of their comfort zones and reach out to their peers.

- We are so excited – we just received 300 Gideon New Testaments in Ukrainian! We are handing them out at camp (and maybe to the authorities who always pull us over, too!) and we believe that God will clearly speak to people through the Bible.
 - May we not lose sight of the reason we are here. So many students will have the chance to clearly choose between a life following God or life in this world, trying to get by “being a good person”. May their ears & hearts be opened to God’s word & their need for a Savior.
 - We just found out 2 of 3 camps are tent camps for 9 nights a piece. This is a serious stretch for many of us. Pray for positive attitude and joy in whatever the circumstance. And pray against rain.
